If the patient has been more forgetful in the last 12 months to the extent it has affected their life and there has been no GP diagnosis of dementia, ask the patient the following questions.

A score of 1 is given if they answer a question correctly, and 0 if they answer incorrectly.

If the patient scores ≤ 7, the patient will need to be referred to their GP. Move onto 'Medication Assessment and MUR' and 'Lifestyle and Signposting', gathering any other information required for the GP referral. Ensure you print the GP referral letter from PharmOutcomes.

If the patient scores  $\geq$  8, there is no cause for concern. Move onto 'Medication Assessment and MUR' and 'Lifestyle and Signposting' sections to see whether there are any medication side effects that can be causing cognitive decline.
