Somerset Community Pharmacies Easter Bank Holidays 2023:

Pharmacies should now have received the final rota for Easter weekend 2023 for pharmacies, opticians and dentists in Somerset.



Actions for Pharmacies:

- The <u>Somerset Community Pharmacies Easter Bank Holidays 2023 webpage</u> is available as a single point of access and includes:
- <u>Somerset Easter Bank Holiday opening hours poster</u> for your area to be clearly displayed in the window of your pharmacy.
- <u>Somerset Easter planning pack</u> containing all the opening hours for community pharmacies, ophthalmic opticians and dental practices in Somerset (all listed on separate tabs).
- Required actions for pharmacies including:
 - Daily pick up patient prescriptions
 - Updating <u>NHS UK</u> and DoS to reflect the opening and closing times of your pharmacy.
 - Claiming payments if you have been commissioned by NHS England South West to open over the Easter bank holidays (claim no than Friday 21st April 2023).
 - Additional actions for any pharmacies open after 5pm over the bank holiday weekend.
- South West Easter Bank Holiday Opening Hours for the whole <u>SW region are available here</u>, together with maps outlining the pharmacies open on the Bank Holidays in the region.

Professional development and wellbeing

1. New clinical skills training offer for community pharmacists launched [Action]



- Health Education England is making available 10,000 module places for clinical skills training for community pharmacists to be delivered by <u>CliniSkills</u> between 17 April 2023 and March 2024.
- This will give community pharmacists the opportunity to build on their existing clinical examination and consultation skills to assess, treat and manage common health problems.
- This offer is available to community pharmacists, including part time staff and locums working in community pharmacy.

- 2. Emergency contraception, safeguarding & child exploitation online training [Book now]
- This training is required for community pharmacists to deliver Emergency contraceptive (EC) services in Somerset under the Somerset County Council PGDs.



- It is for pharmacists new to providing this service or those due for refresher training (minimum every 4 years). Access the PGDs and supporting resources at the <u>LPC website</u>.
- This programme includes:
 - Levonelle and Ulipristal acetate PGDs.
 - o Sexual health.
 - Safeguarding and child exploitation.
 - Local referral pathways.

- A new CPPE e-learning programme *Cancer: supporting people with early diagnosis* is now available to pharmacists, pharmacy technicians and trainee pharmacists.
- Diagnosis of cancer at an early stage improves a person's chance of survival, and pharmacy professionals in any practice setting have opportunities to identify early signs and symptoms.
- On completion of the programme, you will be able to recognise situations where a conversation may be needed about a referral for investigation regarding specific red flag symptoms for certain cancers.

- To reduce prescription costs for women receiving Hormone Replacement Therapy (HRT), on 1 April the Government launched the <u>HRT Pre-Payment Certificate (HRT-PPC)</u>.
- The NHS Business Services Authority (NHSBSA) has published <u>HRT PPC guidance</u> which and includes details for prescribers (chapter 5) and dispensers (chapter 6).
