The Pharmacy Quality Scheme (PQS) forms part of the Community Pharmacy Contractual Framework (CPCF). The 2025/2026 PQS rewards community pharmacy contractors that deliver quality criteria in two quality domains: medicines optimisation and patient safety.

CPPE offer learning and assessments to support you in achieving criteria relating to the medicines optimisation and patient safety domains in the 2025/2026 version of the scheme.

The 2025/2026 PQS includes a stipulation that may require staff to repeat previously completed training and e-assessments. This will depend on the stated validity period and completion dates.
